

In terms of "Magic":

Magic has been my principal hobby as from the age of 10 and I got a boost when I saw Fred Kaps perform live at the jubileum of my local gymnastic club when I was 12. At 15 years' old I joined my first magic society (Arnhem) as the only "junior member". In Groningen I joined Passe Passe and – while abroad – I joined the Magic Society in Sao Paulo (Brazil), the IBM Ring in Atlanta (Georgia) and the IBM Ring in Pittsburgh (Pennsylvania). In short I consider myself an avid amateur (« part time pro »).

Back in Holland I joined several magic societies such as The Black Muze, The Micromagic Society, Mysterium Amsterdam (then with Tommy Wonder, Dick Koornwinder and Fl!p)) and for 25 years I was the secretary of Hands Down, the oldest magic society in Holland. Currently I am a member of the Magic Society of Central Netherlands and of the Amsterdam Magic Society.

I have been a Vice President of the NMU for 6 years, have been the Chief Editor of the NMU Magic Magazine – also for 6 years – managing the transition "from print to digital" and continue currently as a reporter and contributor.

With regard to FISM: I have attended almost all FISM Conventions, starting in 1973 in Paris (only missing Vienna and Yokohama) and several of the FISM ECM's. I have frequently featured as a member of the jury for the Close Up competition, I am currently member of the Audit Committee, of the Intellectual Property Rights Committee and of the Legal Committee among other advising on the revision of The Statutes and Rules of Contest and advising on such matters as contractual disputes, drafting of contracts, plagiarism / copy right issues and/or the correct interpretation and application of the various FISM rules. Blackpool and Masters of Magic also feature as my favourite magic conventions.
